



Are you interested in helping us improve the way in which non-invasive ventilation is delivered to people with motor neurone disease/amyotrophic lateral sclerosis?

We are conducting a research project to help optimise non-invasive ventilation (NIV) for people with motor neurone disease (MND), also known as amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS).

We are carrying out a survey for healthcare professionals who have a role in recommending and/or delivering respiratory care and NIV to people with MND/ALS, to find out about their current clinical practices.

The survey is intended for healthcare professionals working in respiratory or ventilation services **AND** community services in the United Kingdom who have experience delivering respiratory care to people with MND/ALS. For example, this includes respiratory consultants, respiratory nurses, physiotherapists, home ventilation nurses, community matrons, occupational therapists etc.

We expect the survey to take approximately 15-35 minutes and it is open until Tuesday 5th March 2019.
